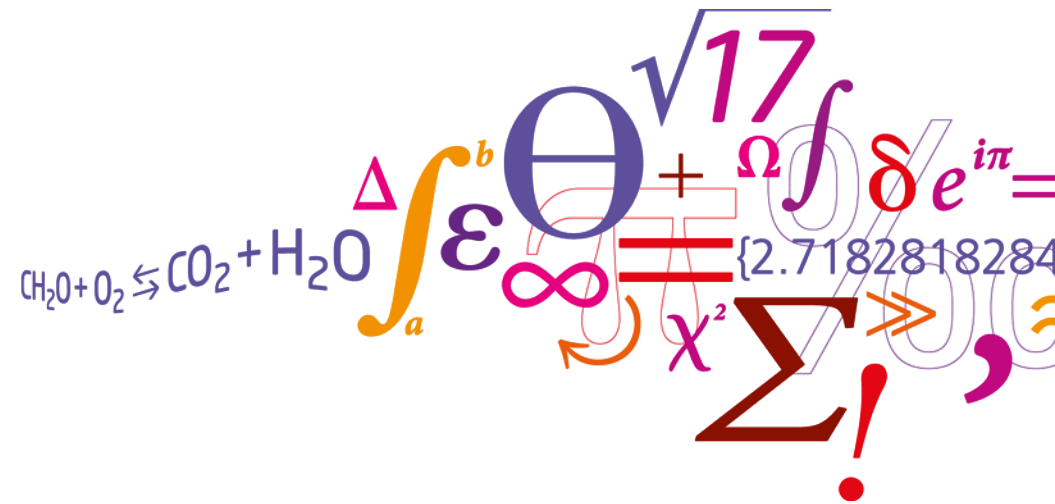


Status from the programme committee

 - Utility scale (3), city (2), basin (1).
 - Each track should receive >100 submissions
- Programme has been finalized,
 - Authors/workshop planners notified
- Coaching of workshops on-going
 - Will continue until end of May (Sept)
- Programme fits conference logistics
 - Three slots because of long walking distances

Experiences in getting national impact

- As PC member you can only get influence via good submissions
